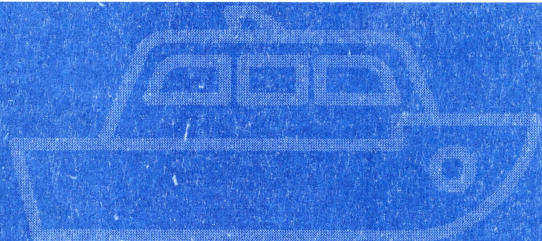


WATER SHUTTLE INFORMATION



WELCOME TO GRAND CAYMAN!

FIRST WATER SHUTTLE: APPROX. 7:15AM LAST WATER SHUTTLE FROM SHORE: 3:15PM

In Grand Cayman we will be anchoring a short distance from land and using water shuttles to transport guests to and from the port. Water shuttles will run back and forth continuously throughout the day.

Here's how you can get off the ship:

A. GUESTS WITH A CARNIVAL SHORE EXCURSION (Best option to make the most of your time in port!)

- Meeting times and locations are printed on your shore excursion tickets:
 - Excursions meeting on board: Please follow the instructions printed on your shore excursion tickets and meet in the designated lounge.
 - Excursions meeting on the pier: Proceed to the gangway on deck 0 Fwd 1 hour before your excursion begins.

B. GUESTS WITHOUT A CARNIVAL SHORE EXCURSION

- On Grand Cayman morning, pick up a water shuttle pass starting at 6:00am on deck 5 Mid next to the JavaBlue Café. Please select a pass with a zone number for the approximate time you would like to go ashore.
- Once you pick up your pass please wait until you hear your zone number called to a gangway. Please note that announcements will not be made inside staterooms.

C. GUESTS WHO ARE IN NO HURRY TO GET OFF (OPEN SHUTTLE TIME)

- After the open shuttle announcement is made (approximately 11:00am), you may proceed straight to the gangway on deck 0 Fwd.
- You DO NOT need a water shuttle pass if you choose this option.

GUESTS USING A MOTORIZED WHEELCHAIR / SCOOTER

- Motorized wheelchairs and scooters can be accommodated on water shuttles.

HEALTH PROTOCOLS FOR GOING ASHORE IN GRAND CAYMAN

- All guests are required to wear masks indoors and on transportation, including water shuttles. Outdoor mask use is strongly recommended.
- All guests are recommended to physically distance 6ft indoors & outdoors.

HELPFUL TIPS:

- Cell phones may sync with local time, please use a watch to stay on ship's time! The last water shuttle leaves shore at 3:15pm ship's time.
- If you hear a series of short blasts on the ship's horn, proceed to the next available water shuttle back on board as this indicates a change in sea conditions that may affect our water shuttle operations.
