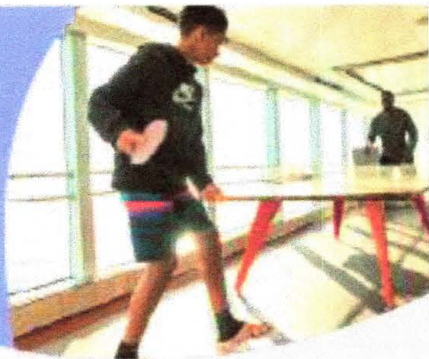

Kids' Club is not offered on cruises of 25-days or longer, including all Legendary and Grand Voyages. We offer a selection of family activities throughout these longer voyages for any children who may be on board.

FREQUENTLY ASKED QUESTIONS

Are there age restrictions or prerequisites?

Yes. All children under 12 must be registered by a parent/guardian before participating.

- **Toilet Training:** Children must be fully toilet-trained and able to use the restroom independently. Diapers and pull-ups are not permitted.
- **Age Groups:** To maintain safety, we provide curated programming for Kids (3–6), Tweens (7–11), and Teens (12–17).
- Lunch is not offered as part of this service.

Activities

- Kids' Club activities are available from 9 am to 12 pm and 1 pm to 4 pm on port days.
- During voyages with a high number of families on board, we will make all efforts to accommodate interested parties. However, participation in our program cannot be guaranteed. Hours of operation may change to better serve our guests.

Safety Comes First

- Safety is our primary concern, and strict policies are in place for effective supervision.
- Bullying, unsafe behavior, or inappropriate language are not tolerated and will result in removal from the program.
- Babysitting or overnight care are not offered.
- Adult guests are not permitted to remain in Kids' Club unless they are attending a child with special needs.
- **Special Needs:** Children with special needs are invited to attend Kids' Club activities based on their chronological age. In some cases, parental supervision may be required.

Sign-In Procedures

- **Ages 3–11:** A parent or authorized guardian (listed on the registration form) must sign the child in and out for every session.
- Children under 12 must wear color-coded wristbands for safety.

Sign-Out Procedures

- Parents going ashore may leave children in the Kids' Club but must provide accurate contact information and return on time for pick up at the end of a session.
- Late pick-ups may result in restrictions or removal from the program.

Health, Safety & Conduct

Children with fever, vomiting, diarrhea, or other contagious symptoms cannot participate until cleared by the medical center.

Prohibited Items

- Phones or cameras, food, drinks, personal toys and toy weapons
- No medications are allowed, except for EpiPens.

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
