





Princess Kids Pager Program

The Youth Staff is pleased to offer a paging system designed especially for the parents of young children who participate in our activities or group kid-sitting programs. In the event we need to contact you while your child is in the youth center, our Youth Staff will be able to reach you with a simple "bleep"! Here's how it works:

All parents with children under the age of 5 will receive a pager when leaving their children at the youth center to participate in activities of babysitting. Parents of children ages 6-12 are welcome to use a pager, available upon request and depending on the availability.

At sign-in, a member of the Youth Staff will issue you a pager that you should keep with you at all times while your child is in the youth center. Please note, pagers do not work ashore. If you receive a "bleep" please call the youth center immediately, or return to the youth center as soon as possible. Parents may be paged for the following reasons:

- · Diaper change needed
- · Continuous crying
- Unruly conduct/inappropriate behavior
- Emergencies

Please return your pager to the Youth Staff when picking your child up during sign out. Please note: A \$50 charge will be applied to your stateroom account for each unreturned, lost, or damaged pager.

We hope you will find this complimentary feature helpful and convenient. We look forward to your child's participation in the Youth Program!

Safety Of Children In An Emergency

Please read the following carefully as it concerns your child's safety.

Safety Wristbands: All children ages 2-12 years old, regardless of their participation in the Youth Program, must wear their Muster Station safety wristband at all times throughout the cruise. If a wristband is lost or damaged, replacements are available from the Guest Services.

CREW ALERT - CONTINUOUS RINGING OF THE SHIP'S ALARM

I. If you hear Crew Alert and your kids are in the Youth Center or at a youth activity, please proceed straight away to the Youth Center (Deck 17, Aft) and collect them. If this signal is sounded while you are attending an organized youth event with your children, they will be handed back to your care. At this stage there is nothing further required of you.

Teenagers ages 13+ will be sent back to their cabins if they are comfortable to leave. Otherwise, they will remain supervised in the Youth Center.

GENERAL EMERGENCY ALARM - SEVEN OR MORE SHORT RINGS FOLLOWED BY ONE LONG RING ON THE ALARM BELLS OR SHIP'S WHISTLE

If you hear the General Emergency Alarm and you have not yet picked up your children, please proceed to your Muster Station and your children will be brought to you by the Youth Staff.

3. In the unlikely event that it is necessary to abandon ship and you have not already collected your children from the Youth Center or at your Muster Station, your children will be evacuated and looked after by the Youth Staff until you can be reunited.

FREQUENTLY ASKED QUESTIONS

What is the sign-in/sign out process?

• For your child's security, all children between the ages of 3-12 must be signed out by a parent/guardian or authorized person (as designated on the registration card by a parent).

What food events take place in the program and what if my child has allergies?

. Youth Staff do not host any food events in the center.

Does my child need to be toilet trained and, what is the policy on children in diapers?

- ·Yes, children must be toilet trained to participate without a parent.
- Our staff is unable to change diapers, provide one-on-one supervision, bottle feed or administer medication.

Do the Youth Center activities include pool games?

- Youth Staff does not facilitate pool games or activities for children ages 3–12.
- Children ages 3-12 using any of the pools onboard, including splash pools adjacent to the Youth Center areas, must be supervised by a parent or guardian at all times.
- · Please check your Princess Patter for more information.

Can my child attend the Youth Program during the port days while I'm off the ship?

•Yes, we offer complimentary Port Day Programming for parents who wish to leave their child onboard while they enjoy a shore excursion.

Do you have babysitting services?

• We offer group kidsitting services in the Youth Center from 10PM – 1AM for children ages 3-11. The fee is \$5 per hour per child. Private in-cabin babysitting is not available.

How would you contact parents in case of emergency or any reason?

 All parents with children under the age of 5 will receive a pager when leaving their children at the youth center to participate in activities or group kidsitting. Parents of children ages 6-12 are welcome to use a pager, available upon request.
