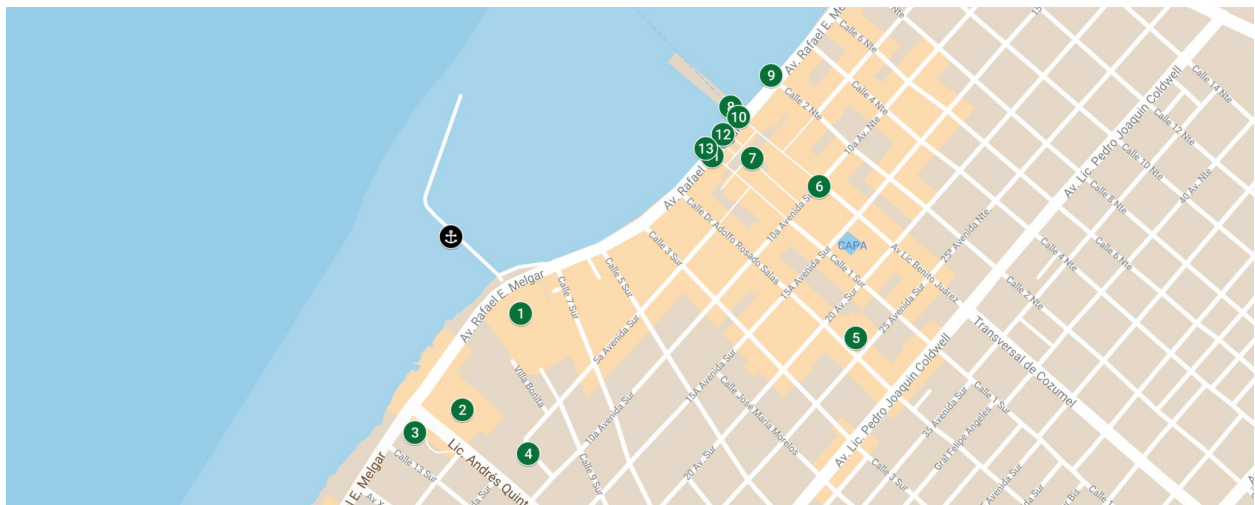

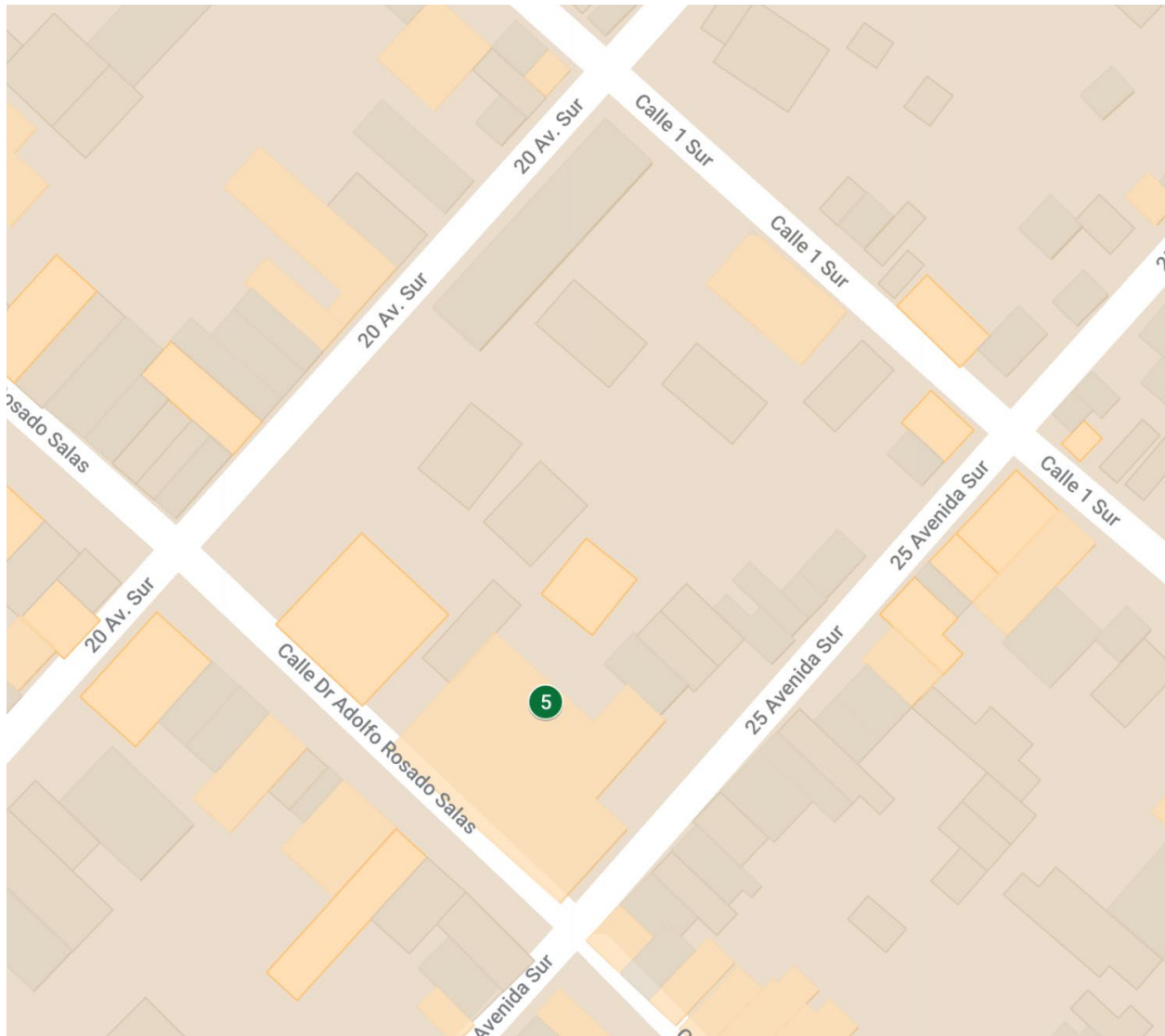
PUNTA LANGOSTA, COZUMEL, MEXICO
