
PUNTA LANGOSTA, COZUMEL, MEXICO

Port Guide Map





Located off the eastern coast of the Yucatan peninsula, Cozumel is Mexico's largest Caribbean island. Cruise ships visiting Cozumel dock near the town of San Miguel, which was named after the patron saint of Cozumel. In our Cozumel (Punta Langosta) Cruise Port Guide, we provide an overview of the points of interest we explored while visiting San Miguel on a cruise ship.



Near the cruise terminal area, you'll find:

- Plaza Punta Langosta (Shopping) and Cozumel Sign: Plaza Punta Langosta is a multi-level, open-air shopping mall that features several shops, restaurants, bathrooms, and a car rental. A large Cozumel sign is located behind Diamonds International.
- 2. MEGA Soriana: In addition to a variety of foods -- including Mexican pastries -they also sell souvenirs and various fun-in-the-sun items you may have forgotten to pack, such as sunscreen, water shoes, and more.
- 3. Cozumel Municipal Park: The park contains a few small playground sets for kids.

5. Municipal Market: The market is full of vendors selling produce, meats, fish, fresh tortilla dough, souvenirs and more. There are also a number of prepared food booths, a courtyard with table seating, and a restroom.

- 9. Coral Reefs Monument: The arch showing sea life and scuba divers signifies Cozumel being a year-round scuba diving destination.

- 11. Mexican War Memorial: A tribute to those who defended Mexico during the Mexican-American conflict that took place in the mid-1800s.
